Jacaranda selling fast

JACARANDA, a \$40 million Mudgeeraba Jacaranda project has reported more than \$3.9 million in sales since its launch just three weeks ago.

Seven of the 24 villas in stage one have been sold.

The gated community on an 8.5ha natural bushland site will have 66 luxury villas built over three stages.

It was given the green light by council last year.

Developer and Gold Coast property industry veteran, Peter McLean said he was pleased with the results.

“The majority of buyers are locals from Robina, Mudgeeraba and Burleigh Heads and we’ve had quite a few enquiries from Brisbane,” he said.

“Due to the demand and with sales tracking well, we’ll look at launching stage two before Christmas.”
